Team managers will also be given team clothing and an honorarium to help cover any travel costs for practices.

Description: The Team Manager will perform the duties associated with the day-to-day business of the team, including but not limited to;

- Being the main point of contact for parents of your team
- Managing registrations
- Volunteer coordination for games and events
- Coordinating and preparing for parent meetings
- Managing fundraising initiatives
- Weekly team communications
- Perform administrative duties as necessary before and during National/Regional competitions by ensuring Football Canada timelines are met.

- Perform all team duties in the best interests of FNB, both financially and in respect for everyone's safety
- Must always conduct themselves favourably without bias and shall take all steps to maintain the integrity of the players, coaches, support staff, and Football New Brunswick.

Required Qualifications:

- The Team Manager position is subject to a criminal record check and Safe Sport online training
- Experience managing and working with others in a team environment
- Strong communication skills
- Strong organizational skills and ability to follow processes
- Ability to manage conflict in a professional manner
- Available on evenings and weekends
- The ideal candidate is free of any conflicts of interest, such as having a child on the team they are managing
- Applicants for these positions are always expected to represent the organization in a professional manner while abiding by all FNB policies.
