Although this is a volunteer position, managers will go to their respective National events where all travel, meals and accommodations are included. Team managers will also be given team clothing and an honorarium to help cover any travel costs for practices.

**Reports to:** Director of Coach, Athlete and Official Development, Football NB

**Description:** The Team Manager will perform the duties associated with the day-to-day business of the team, including but not limited to;

- Being the main point of contact for parents of your team
- Managing registrations
- Volunteer coordination for games and events
- Coordinating and preparing for parent meetings
- Managing fundraising initiatives
- Weekly team communications

- Perform administrative duties as necessary before and during National/Regional competitions by ensuring Football Canada timelines are met.
- Perform all team duties in the best interests of FNB, both financially and in respect for everyone's safety
- Must always conduct themselves favorably without bias and shall take all steps to maintain the integrity of the players, coaches, support staff, and Football New Brunswick.

### **Required Qualifications:**

- The Team Manager position is subject to a criminal record check and Safe Sport online training
- Experience managing and working with others in a team environment
- Strong communication skills
- Strong organizational skills and ability to follow processes
- Ability to manage conflict professionally
- Available on evenings and weekends
- The ideal candidate is free of any conflicts of interest, such as having a child on the team they are managing
- Applicants for these positions are always expected to represent the organization professionally while abiding by all FNB policies.

Within the application we will require a list of your qualifications, relevant experience, willingness to obtain a criminal record check and complete the safe sport training. Please provide three references (one of which must be football related).

- Be a member in good standing with FNB.
- Have a clean Criminal Record Check.
- Not participate in any for-profit football initiatives. This would include owning a for-profit camp/program of your own, or assisting or working in a for-profit camp/program in New Brunswick.
