## **ABOUT TEAM ATLANTIC**

Football New Brunswick (FNB) in partnership with Football Nova Scotia (FNS) and Football PEI (FPEI) are entering a Team Atlantic in the 2026 Women's National Championships. In preparation for this event, we are beginning our selection process this year. This includes selecting the coaching staff, offering two ID camps and using the MWFL season as an identification opportunity.

Team Atlantic will compete in the 2026 Senior Women's Nationals, which will include a full selection process and training camp in 2026 leading up to the event. The Senior Women's Nationals is the pathway for women interested in representing Team Canada at the Women's World Championships in 2027.

### **HEAD COACH OVERVIEW**

Primary Work Locations: Practices will be held in New Brunswick & Nova Scotia

The Head Coaching positions shall be appointed by a selection committee comprised of members from New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. Coaches applying for these positions are always expected to represent Team Atlantic professionally while abiding by the all relative policies.

Furthermore, Team Atlantic Coaches must always conduct themselves favorably without bias and shall take all steps to maintain the integrity of the players, coaches, support staff, the Atlantic PSO's and Football Canada.

### **HEAD COACH DUTIES**

Head Coaches will perform all team duties in the best interests of Team Atlantic, both financially and in respect for everyone's safety. They will at no time feign to represent Team Atlantic outside their selected capacity or recruit players for their other coaching realms.

The following are some of the duties required of the head coach:

- Will be responsible and available for all player functions and meetings as designated by Team Atlantic.
- Take the lead with team discipline involving coaches, and collaborate with the other two Coordinators to initiate player discipline.
- Plan and implement all game plans, practices and schedules.
- Act as the media speaker for the team with the guidance of Team Atlantic.
- Work with coaches and all staff.
- Be willing to travel as required by Team Atlantic with an honorarium for mileage, meals and accommodations.
- Comply with all policies, procedures and materials as outlined by Team Atlantic, including the Safe Sport policy.
- As a representative of Team Atlantic, the Head Coach's philosophy and views will align with the organization's core mission, value and vision statements.

### **COORDINATOR AND POSITION COACH OVERVIEW**

Primary Work Locations: Practices will be held in New Brunswick & Nova Scotia

The team's Head Coaches will select their coordinators, with final approval coming from Team Atlantic. Furthermore, Team Atlantic Coaches must always conduct themselves favorably without bias and shall take all steps to maintain the integrity of the players, coaches, support staff, and Team Atlantic. Coaches will assist Team Atlantic in their role to further the development of Atlantic region female football players, while challenging the players and treating them with the utmost respect.

### **COORDINATOR AND POSITION COACH DUTIES**

Coaches will perform all team duties in the best interests of Team Atlantic, both financially and with respect for everyone's safety. They will at no time feign to represent Team Atlantic outside their selected capacity or recruit players for their other coaching realms. They will adhere to all Team Atlantic policies and guidelines and act within the Mission and Vision statements, best representing Team Atlantic.

#### **Coordinators**

- Will be responsible and available for all team functions and meetings as designated by Team Atlantic.
- Will report to the Head Coach.
- Will follow the lead of the Head Coach and plan segments of practice and or camps.
- Will collaborate with the Head Coach regarding player or positional coach discipline.
- Will lead interactions with their positional coaches.
- Will organize, teach, and provide direction for their coordinated group within the practice schedule and meetings.
- Will provide and take part in film review of their respective coordinated group
- Be willing to travel as required by Team Atlantic, with compensation for mileage, meals and accommodations in the form of an honorarium.
- Refrain from engaging in any public media regarding the team.

- Must comply with all policies, procedures and materials as outlined by Team Atlantic including Harassment, Safety and Screening, Code of Conduct and Disciplinary policies.
- As a representative of Team Atlantic, represent the Head Coach's philosophy and views and align with the organization's (respective PSO and NSO) core mission, value and vision statements

#### Positional Coaches

- Will be responsible and available for all team functions and meetings as designated by Team Atlantic.
- Will report to the Head Coach, in addition to either the Offensive or Defensive Coordinator.
- Will follow the lead of the Head Coach and lead segments of practice and or camps involving their position, provided by the Offensive or Defensive Coordinator.
- Will report player discipline to the Head Coach.
- Will lead interactions with their positional players.
- Be willing to travel as required by Team Atlantic, with compensation for mileage, meals and accommodations in the form of an honorarium.
- Refrain from engaging in any public media regarding the team.
- Comply with all policies, procedures and materials as outlined by the PSO(s) and the NSO, including Harassment, Safety and Screening, Code of Conduct and Disciplinary policies.
- As a representative of Team Atlantic, represent the Head Coach's philosophy and views and align with the organization's core mission, value and vision statements.

- Have completed or willing to complete a minimum of 2 of the following NCCP multi-sport modules
  - Developing Athletic Abilities
  - Prevention and Recovering
  - Psychology of Performance
  - Coaching and Leading Effectively
  - Managing Conflict + Evaluation
  - Leading Drug-Free Sport + Evaluation
- Be willing to have a practice evaluation completed during Training Camp.
- NCCP Intro to Competition with at least two NCCP position courses.
- Up-to-date courses including Safe Contact, Safe Sport, Making Headway and MED Online Evaluation.
- Knowledgeable in football rules and game management.
- Team Leader, critical thinker, organized, planner, follow direction, respectful.
- Willing to make a 2-year commitment to the program.

- Sign Statement of Nondisclosure.

### **COORDINATORS**

Commitment: February 2025 through Women's Nationals in 2026.

- Minimum three years coaching, with two years as a coordinator.
- Completion of, or intends to complete NCCP Intro to Competition with a minimum of two NCCP position courses within the offensive or defensive team they seek to coordinate.
- Up-to-date courses including Safe Contact, Safe Sport, Making Headway and MED Online Evaluation
  - Knowledgeable of football rules and game management.
  - Team Leader, critical thinker, organized, planner, follow direction, respectful.
  - Willing to make a 2-year commitment to the program.
  - Sign Statement of Nondisclosure.

### **POSITION COACH**

Commitment: February 2025 through Women's Nationals in 2026.

- Minimum three years coaching, with two years as a Head Coach.
- Up-to-date courses including Safe Sport, Making Headway and MED Online Evaluation
- Knowledgeable of football rules and game management.
- Team Leader, critical thinker, organized, planner, follow direction, respectful.
- Willing to make a 2-year commitment to the program.
- Sign Statement of Nondisclosure.

## **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

All interested applicants shall apply online here, by February 20th, 2025. Within the application we will require a list of your qualifications, relevant experience, willingness to obtain a criminal record check and complete the safe sport training as well as three references (two of which must be football related).

To be eligible, a coach must:

- Be a Canadian citizen and resident of NB, NS, PEI or NFLD.
- Be a member in good standing with your respective PSO.
- Have a clean Criminal Record Check.
- Not participate in any for-profit coaching initiatives. This would include owning a for-profit camp/program of your own, or assisting or working in a for-profit camp/program in Canada.
