## Game Plan - FNB's Strategic Plan update

Football NB is currently in Year 3 of its 5-year strategic plan. This year, we evaluated our progress and established new strategies. The first quarter of our operational plan is complete, marked by several new i nitiatives and organizational updates.

**Governance:** We are undergoing a comprehensive Bylaws review to shape the future framework of our organization. This process is expected to be completed by June, with implementation planned for the 2026 AGM. Additionally, our Concussion Policy has been updated to align with the latest 2024 Canadian Guidelines on Concussion in Sport.

**Growth Initiatives:** Thanks to Go NB Provincial grants, we continued our focus on flag football growth, successfully introducing the sport in numerous community schools across the province.

**Key Focus Areas:** We have established working groups dedicated to two critical areas: Officials Growth Strategy and Athlete Development Pathway. We are encouraged by the ongoing collaboration, open dialogue, and commitment from all minor associations and the New Brunswick Football Officials Association as we plan for future growth.

**Looking Ahead:** As we enter the second quarter, our priority is delivering the best possible high-performance season for our athletes and coaches. Our members will be running their flag and tackle leagues throughout New Brunswick. We are also excited to host the 2nd Annual Flag Provincials in Fredericton on June 14-15, where teams will compete for a chance to advance to Nationals.
